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
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Important Safety Precautions

Congratulations on purchasing your new digital photo frame. With this Digital Photo Frame, you can easily and quickly view photos directly from your digital camera's memory card. You can even create a slideshow with multiple transition effects. The Digital Photo Frame is compatible with Secure Digital (SD) cards (including SDHC and SDXC cards up to 32 GB), Multi Media Cards (MMC), and USB flash drives.

- High voltage inside. Do not open the casing of the digital photo frame. Refer servicing to qualified personnel only.
- To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this product to rain or moisture.
- To avoid data loss, do not insert or remove memory cards or USB device when the power is on.

Safety Instructions

- Do not expose the product to dripping or splashing liquids or objects filled with liquids, such as vases. **Use in a dry location only.**
- Keep product away from open flames, such as candles.
- Keep the digital photo frame clean and never store it near a heat source or in dirty, humid or wet places. Keep it out of direct sunlight.
- Press the buttons gently. Pressing them or the screen too hard can damage the digital photo frame.
- Do not use the product in an extremely dry environment as this can lead to static discharge, which can damage the digital photo frame.
- Do not subject the product to harsh impacts. Do not drop the product. These may result in damage to the product and loss of data.
- Do not attempt to repair or disassemble the unit yourself. Only qualified service personnel should perform repairs.
- The digital photo frame is for **indoor use only**.
- Use only the DC 5V power adapter supplied with this product. Do not unplug the adapter while viewing the pictures.

- Do not block the ventilation holes on the back of the digital photo frame.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product.
- To prevent overheating and damage to the screen, unplug the product when you do not intend to use it for a long period of time.
- Insert the plug into the DC IN jack completely on the unit before connecting the AC adapter to an electrical outlet.
- This product can only display files with compatible formats.
- Do not use the product in temperatures over 105° F (40° C).
- Do not allow metallic objects to touch the DC plug when the player is on.

Care and Maintenance

- Always turn off the unit and remove the power adaptor from the electrical outlet before cleaning the unit.
- Use a soft dry cloth to clean this product.
- Never spray or pour liquids directly onto the screen or casing.
- Do not use abrasive materials or chemical cleaners such as alcohol, benzene, etc. Do not allow any water or other liquid to enter the device.
- Do not drop the device; it contains sensitive electronics and cannot withstand shock from falls.
- Do not hit or scratch the screen. Handle it with care. The LED panel of the photo frame is made of glass and therefore is sensitive to excessive force and contact with sharp objects.



Parts and Controls

1	Play/Pause Button HI : Press to select an option from the on-screen menu. In slideshow mode, press to pause/resume a slideshow.
2	Power/Menu Button: Press to access the on-screen menu. Press and hold to shut photo frame off and turn frame back on.
3	Exit Button: Press to exit the current menu and display the previous menu
4	Right Arrow Button ▶ : Press to navigate down through on-screen menu options and thumbnail images
5	Left Arrow Button III : Press to navigate left through on-screen menu options and thumbnail images
6	Down Arrow Button Y: Press to navigate up through on-screen menu options and thumbnail images
7	Up Arrow Button A : Press to navigate up through on-screen menu options and thumbnail images
8	Card reader slot for inserting SD/MMC cards
9	USB port for inserting most USB devices
10	DC IN Jack for connecting included AC Adapter

Getting Started

- Attach the stand to the rear of the Digital Photo Frame in either the horizontal or vertical position; orient it so that the frame sits at the desired angle. To wall mount the Digital Photo Frame instead, see the section below on wall mounting.
- 2. Insert your memory card or your USB flash drive.
- Connect the power adapter to the photo frame and plug it into an electrical outlet.

Wall Mounting

- 1. Insert a nail, screw, or hook into the wall in a location that will support the frame's weight.
- 2. Leave at least 1/2" (about 12mm) of the nail or screw exposed.
- 3. Hang the Digital Photo Frame onto the nail or screw.

Connecting a USB Flash Drive

To view photos from a USB flash drive, insert it into the USB port on the side of the frame.

NOTE:


- Not all USB storage devices are compatible with this digital photo frame.
- USB drive must be formatted using the FAT32 file system. Drives formatted as NTFS or exFAT will not be recognized.


Inserting a Memory Card


To view the pictures from a memory card, insert it into the slot marked "SD/MMC CARD" on the side of the Digital Photo Frame with the metal contacts of the card facing toward the LCD Display.

NOTE:

- Do not force the memory card into the slot. If you are not able tc insert the memory card easily, you may have inserted it incorrectly; turn the card over and try again.
- Do not remove a memory card immediately after inserting it or when the frame is processing files. Wait until the screen is stable.
- Maximum SD/MMC card size is 32GB and USB flash drive size is 128GB.








Connecting the Power Supply

- 1. Place the frame on a flat, stable surface.
- 2. Plug the DC plug of the adapter to the jack marked "DC IN 5V" on the side of the digital photo frame, and then connect power adapter to a standard 110-Volt AC electrical outlet. The player will power on.
- 3. Press and hold the Power/Menu Button to power the frame on or off.
- 4. When the unit is not being used for a long time, press the Power/Menu Button on the unit to power it off and unplug the AC adapter from the electrical outlet.



Display Source

If the frame is off, press and hold the Power/Menu Button to power on the frame. After the card/drive is read, a slide show will start. Press the Exit Button to stop the slide show and enter File Browser mode. Press the Exit Button again to access the main menu. Press the Exit Button a third time to enter Source Mode, in which you can select a photo source from the memory devices inserted into the frame-- memory card, USB flash drive, or the frame's internal memory. Press the Play/Pause button to return to the main menu.

NOTE: Large capacity memory cards and USB drives may take extra time to load.

When in Source Mode, press the left and right Arrow Buttons to choose an input source: Internal Memory, Memory Card or USB Flash Drive. Press the Button to confirm and return to the Main Menu

Main Menu



Press the left and right Arrow Buttons to select Photo, Calendar, Browser, or Setting. Press the play/pause button to confirm. See below for descriptions of each of these modes

Browser



Displays a list of photos on the left with a thumbnail of the selected image on the right. Press the up and down Arrow Buttons to select a photo.

Copy to Internal Memory

To copy the selected image to the frame's internal memory, press the Right Arrow Button to access the on-screen menu. Use the Up and Down Arrow Buttons to select "Copy" and then press the Play/Pause Button to bring up the Confirm Copy window. Press the Right or Left Arrow Buttons to highlight "Yes" or "No" and then press the Play/Pause Button to confirm.

Delete Photo

To delete the selected image, press the Right Arrow Button to access the on-screen menu. Use the Up and Down Arrow Buttons to select "Delete" and then press the Play/Pause Button to bring up the Confirm Delete window. Press the Right or Left Arrow Buttons to highlight "Yes" or "No" and then press the Play/Pause Button to confirm.

Slideshow

Press the Play/Pause Button again to start a slideshow with the selected image. Press the Exit Button to return to the browser screen.

Photo

From the main menu, press the Left and Right Arrow Buttons to select "Photo" and then press the Play/Pause Button to display a thumbnail image gallery. Press the Up, Down, Right, and Left Arrow Buttons to select an image and then press the Play/Pause Button to begin a slide show with that image. To pause, press the Play/ Pause Button again. Press the Exit Button to return to the thumbnail gallery screen.

Working with Photos

During a slideshow, press the Menu Button to display the on-screen menu.



Options available for manipulating the selected photo are Slideshow Interval, Delete, Information, and Gamma Correction. See below for descriptions of each of these functions. Press the Exit Button to resume the slide show. To rotate a photo, simply press the Up or Down Arrow Buttons when the image you want to rotate appears during a slide show and then press the Play/Pause Button to continue to slide show. Each press of the Up or Down Arrow Button will rotate the photo 90°.

Slideshow Interval - Select an image display duration of 3 seconds, 5 seconds, 15 seconds, 30 seconds, 1 minute, 5 minutes, 15 minutes, 30 minutes, or 1 hour

Delete - Deletes the selected image

Information - File name, Resolution, File Size, Created Date

Gamma Correction - Changes gamma values of images, which is similar to brightness but affects an image in a nonlinear manner. Choices are Channel (RGB, Red, Green, Blue), GrayScale (-100 to +100), Brightness (-100 to +100), Contrast (-100 to +100)

Calendar

From the main menu, press the Left and Right Arrow Buttons to select "Calendar" and then press the Play/Pause Button to enter Calendar mode. In this mode, your photos will display as a small slide show on the left along with the time display, while a monthly calendar displays on the right. Press the Up and Down Arrow Buttons to change the year and press the Left and Right Arrow Buttons to adjust the date. Press the Exit button to exit Calendar mode and return to the main menu.



Setup

From the main menu, press the Menu Button to display the setup menu. Press the Up and Down Arrow Buttons to select Photo Setup, Calendar Setup, or System Setup and press the Play/Pause Button to confirm. Use the Left and Right Arrow Buttons to change a highlighted setting. To return to the setup menu, press the Exit Button.

Photo Setup

Icon Action - Choices are "Thumbnail" (displays thumbnail gallery after selecting "Photo" from main menu) or "Slideshow" (begins a slide show after selecting "Photo" from main menu)

Display Ratio - Choices are "Auto Fit," "Optimal," or "Full Screen." Most images display best using the "Auto Fit" option

Slide Show Interval - Selects an image display duration from three seconds to one hour

Slideshow Repeat - Choices are "Repeat" (restarts a slideshow after the last image is displayed) or "No Repeat" (returns to main menu after all images have been displayed)

Slideshow Mode - Choices are "Single Window" (one image fills the screen), "Two Windows" (two images display simultaneously side by side), "Three Windows" (three images display simultaneously), or "Four Windows" (four images display simultaneously)

Slideshow Order - Choices are "Sequential" (images display in order) or "Random" (images display in random order)

Calendar Setup

Set Date - Sets the date, month, and year Set Time - Sets the time of day Set Time Format - 12-hour or 24-hour time display

System Setup

Language - Press the Left and Right Arrow Buttons to choose English/French/ German/Italian/Spanish/Portuguese/Swedish/Dutch language for menus.

Gamma - Select a gamma correction value from 1 - 100

Brightness - Changes the screen brightness value from 1 - 100

Contrast - Changes the screen contrast value from 1 - 100

Auto Power Off - Accesses an on-screen menu where you can select a time of day for the photo frame to power off. Use the Up, Down, Left, and Right Arrow Buttons to set.

Auto Power On - Accesses an on-screen menu where you can select a time of day for the photo frame to power on. Use the Up, Down, Left, and Right Arrow Buttons to set.

Auto Power Frequency - Selects when to activate the Auto Power settings. Choices are Weekend, Weekdays, Daily, and Once.

Start Up Mode - Choose whether to automatically begin a slide show when the frame powers on. Choices are Photos (slide show begins automatically) and Off (main menu will display when powered on).

Version - Displays firmware revision number

Reset Settings - Select to bring up an on-screen menu where Yes and No will appear; select Yes and then the Play/Pause Button to return all settings to their factory defaults.
